- ✓ Protection of surface and underground water resources, preventing possible contamination and accidental spills of dangerous substances;

- ✓ Expansion of the number of products to increase the recovery of materials;
- ✓ Progressive renewal of the equipment park;
- ✓ Open dialogue with interested parties on the environmental effects of business activity and guarantee of cooperation with public authorities.
